During these operations, we have recognized that plastic pollution is the most pervasive issue. The harmful effects of plastic pollution on health, the economy, and the environment cannot be ignored. Our planet is drowning in plastic, with over 400 million tons produced annually, half of which is intended for single-use purposes. Shockingly, less than 10% of all plastic produced is recycled. It is estimated that between 19 and 23 million tonnes of plastic end up in lakes, rivers, and oceans each year. Plastic waste is now clogging our landfills, polluting our oceans, and releasing toxic fumes, making it one of the gravest threats to our planet.

What is lesser known is that microplastics are also present in the food we consume, the water we drink, and even the air we breathe. Many plastic products contain dangerous additives that pose a significant threat to our health.

At ALTRAD, we recognize our crucial role in combating this pollution, and we are committed to strengthening our contribution. We have adopted a strict policy that promotes proper waste management and encourages the reduction, reuse, and recycling of plastic materials and products.

The key to our success in fighting pollution, particularly plastic pollution, lies in team mobilization and involving all our stakeholders. By engaging our employees and the communities in which we operate, we can meet this challenge head-on.
